

Preparing for ICAO's Updated Obstacle Limitation Surfaces

TAME DANKER OF THE PARTY OF THE

The International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) is revising its Obstacle Limitation Surface (OLS) regulations for the first time since the 1950s to address advancements in aviation technology and operations.

The updated framework introduces two classifications: Obstacle Free Surfaces (OFS), protecting airspace for standard operations, and Obstacle Evaluation Surfaces (OES), assessing obstacle acceptability for safe and regular aircraft operations.

These changes aim to improve safety and operational efficiency by addressing current and future airport needs. Transoft recommends airports monitor ICAO's implementation timeline, and start looking for tools that will prepare them for the OLS changes.

Michael Frost, Senior Product Manager at Transoft, says "The changes will require the industry to react and relearn the fundamental processes of OLS and aeronautical studies. Tools like SkySAFE hope

to ease that burden by building in the regulations and workflows to expedite the industry's ability to evaluate airport airspace by both legacy and newly adopted regulations."

A compliance date is set for 2030, with supporting industry tools and training planned to assist in adapting to the new requirements.

We are closely monitoring ICAO's development and are standing by to provide access to the new regulations in SkySAFE once officially adopted ***
